Unfinished/New Business

- The weeds were bad this year. They had to spray 4 times, 2 of the sprays were warranty work.

- Annual meeting November 12, 2020 will be cancelled due to Covid-19. The annual meeting will be a mail in meeting only. There will be a Zoom session for owners to ask questions on November 12th at 8:30 am.
- Jared, Randy, Jeff, Kristie, and Nic from Monarch all met to go over the property lines and drainage into Valley Street. Nic moved the fence and put in a berm to divert the rain runoff to the street before it comes over the hill into Valley Street.
- Jared is going to get Valley Street a bid for fixing the drainage area behind #1.
- Jared will do the annual roof check and will let everyone know the roof's condition.
- Kristie will call Nic from Monarch to make sure he is still doing snow removal it needed.
- Kristie received a bid from Seal Coat Solutions to put sealcoat of the parking lot. It also suggested we fix a few spots in the asphalt. Kristie is to get a second bid.
- Concrete Xperts fixed the valve clean out areas in the parking lot.
- Jared is going to get Valley Street a bid for fixing the drainage area behind #1.
- Kristie talked with El Paso County Engineering and Planning about adding a parking lot in the rock area in front of #10. The first step is to submit a Site Development Amendment Plan. That costs \$1847.00 to have it reviewed, it can be revised 3 times with no additional charges. When Jared talked to planning, they were not hopeful that it would be approved at all.
